At Dover High School and Regional Career Technical Center (CTC), students gain a strong traditional education *and* practical, hands-on experiences that prepare them to be college and career ready.

Credit Bearing Programs

Work Experience

Work Experience is designed to provide students with employability and job seeking skills while earning high school credit. This program helps students apply knowledge and skills in real-world settings while gaining professional experiences that can be placed on a resume.

.25 credits for 120 hours worked/max. 1/2credit per year

Cooperative Education Program

The Cooperative Education Program (Co-op) combines career and technical coursework with part-time paid work-experience. Students must be enrolled in an approved career technical program and the training site must relate to the career technical program the student is enrolled in.

.25 credits for 90 hours worked/max. 1/2credit per year

Internship Program

The internship program is a supervised work-based learning experience that offers students a structured, on-the-job experience related to the student's college and career plan.

.25 credits for 67.5hours worked/max. 1/2credit per year
